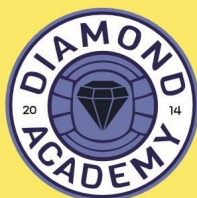
Applications received after the closing date are treated as 'late applications' and less likely to be offered one of their preferred schools.



The money raised will be donated through Parentlink to schools to spend on what they need most. This won't affect your own Cashpot earn.

Each school will get an additional £50 added to their Cashpot, after at least one customer has shopped and scanned their Rewards app.
